- Call to Order: The meeting will be called to order and roll will be taken @ 4pm.
- Announcements: No New Announcement
- Construction Prolonged (Discussion) Our facilities are transforming into a beautiful campus. Our contractor, All Season Windows, is working
 after-school and weekends to finish scope of work. Campus Maintenance staff Jason McCollum and Devon Barnard will be on hand to discuss
 progress to date and answer any BOD questions. Note: At this point we on target to spend all of our \$2,000,000 budget. (Att 1)
- Unfinished Work Priorities (Discussion): While we have been made great strides in our effort to restore our campus (Est: 95% of all deferred
 maintenance has been addressed), there are still some pretty big unfunded/unaddressed maintenance items. While a few of these will require
 immediate attention and need to be addressed sooner than later (Top Priority), our intention is to identify resources and address all these issues
 before September of 2026. Remaining item include:
 - Re-pipe outflow plumbing in bldg. A (Will require contractor and could be very expensive) TOP PRIORITY
 - Re surface roof on Hope Center Est: 10K for materials (labor can be done inhouse) TOP PRIORITY
 - Repair Roof on gym Est: 10K for materials (can be done in house) TOP PRIORITY
 - Refurbish (paint & flooring) vestibule in gym- Est: 5k (can be done inhouse)
 - Replace Gym Lights with LED Est: 20k (contractor)
 - Refurbish basement of bldg. A Est. 20k (some contracting but most done inhouse)
 - Stage curtains Est. 10k (Vendor)
 - Classroom updates B 13,14,15 Est:7K each. done inhouse)
- Sale or Lease of North Lot (Discussion): Mauricio Alvarez, the owner of La Tapitia Market, has reached out to inquire whether the Board would
 consider selling or entering into a long-term lease for the unused and unimproved lot located adjacent to the west side of his store, just north of
 RPA's main parking area. The market is situated on Stark Street, directly east of the McDonald's restaurant. Mr. Nelsen will facilitate a discussion
 among the Board of Directors to determine their stance on this proposal. (Att 2)
- Enrollment (Discussion): Reynolds School District is facing a serious enrollment crisis. For example, we have reports that Alder and Woodland Elementary schools have started the year with just enough kindergarteners to fill ONE Class (each) and both schools have three K teachers! We are not sure what the underlying cause of this is.
 - While RPA's 25-26 enrollment has increased by nearly 40 students (368 to 406) and will have a very strong kindergarten cohort (76), we are currently at 406 students which is 97% of our budget (420). Mr. Nelsen will talk to the BOD about strategies going forward.
- Middle School Follow-Up (Discussion ONLY): Mr. Nelsen will briefly follow-up with the BOD on June's discussion of adding a middle school in the mid-range future.
- June & July 2025 Financials (Motion): The BOD will consider and discuss June & July 2025 financials as provided by True-Blue Accounting.
 Tonya Mosher will be on-hand to answer BOD questions. (monthly financial send directly to directors in separate e-mails.
